STANDING ORDERS

Note: The Bank will not undertake to

- a) make any reference to Value Added Tax or pay a stated sum plus V.A.T. or other indeterminate element

- c) advise beneficiary of inability to pay
- d) request beneficiary's bank to advise beneficiary of receipt
- e) accept instructions to pay as soon after the specified date as there are funds to meet the payment, if funds are not available on a specified date

Payments may take 3 working days to reach the beneficiary's account. Your branch can give you further details

GIFT AID DECLARATION

1. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the NHS Retirement Fellowship.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income or capital gains equal to the tax in the UK that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
